PhD COMPREHENSIVE EXAM APPLICATION

Prior to submitting the Comprehensive Exam application, Ph.D. students must identify their intended Dissertation Supervisors using the <u>Declare a Research Supervisor form</u>. To be eligible to write the Comprehensive Exam, Ph.D. students must have completed all of the core course requirements and two consecutive summer residencies. Students must have defined their research area before submitting their preferred date for the examination. Students must identify, **four weeks in advance**, the date on which they intend to submit the completed exam. There will be two questions on the exam.

The grade for the exam is pass/fail. Completed exam responses will be reviewed by the dissertation supervisor; a full member of the Education graduate faculty, and at the discretion of the dissertation supervisor, the supervisory committee or other full members of GSE who are chosen for their level of expertise (optional).
