How to Apply

The majority of job postings at the Simcoe Muskoka Catholic District School Board are applied to through Apply to Education. In order to apply, you will have to complete the steps below :

- 1) Register with Apply to Education at smcdsb.simplification.com
- 2) Complete your portfolio
- 3) Apply to a job posting

Do I have to be Catholic to work at SMCDSB?

You must be Catholic for the following positions: Teacher, Designated Early Childhood Educator, Principal, Vice-Principal, Superintendent, Associate Director and Director. Applications for these positions must include a pastoral reference. Being Catholic is not a requirement for all other positions.

Do I need a Criminal Background Check to apply at SMCDSB?

As an applicant you do not require a criminal background check (CBC) but if you are offered a position with our board you must provide an original CBC including the Vulnerable Sector Screening and it must be dated within six months of the date of your interview. You will be provided with the necessary paperwork to obtain a CBC at the time of your interview.
