Use the full names of all authors. List the first author by last name and use standard name format for subsequent authors.

Write the article's title in proper title format with a period at the end and in quotation marks.

Harper, Lin, and Jerry Ross. "An Application of Knowles' Theories of Adult Education to an Undergraduate Degree Program." *Journal of Continuing Higher Education*. 59.3 (2011): Education Research Complete. Web. 17 Oct. 2013.

Hanging indent.

Italicize the journal's title and the name of the database you used. For some assignments, professors will want a variety of databases in order to demonstrate that you've looked at a variety of research.

Did you find this article online or in print?

When did you find the article? Day, month (short form with a period), year.

Volume and issue number. Year of publication in parentheses.
